**BOULDER CITY HOSPITAL FOUNDATION ANNOUNCES DATES FOR  
47<sup>TH</sup> ANNUAL ART IN THE PARK EVENT**

Boulder City Hospital Foundation announced today that the 47<sup>th</sup> Annual Art in the Park event will take place the weekend of October 3-4, 2009. Art in the Park is one of the largest outdoor juried art festivals in the Southwest and is the largest fundraiser for the Boulder City Hospital Foundation. The event features over 400 original artists in the fine art, fine/contemporary craft and traditional craft categories.

Art in the Park is free to the public, and although Boulder City's population is just over 16,800, the event draws over 100,000 visitors. The event takes place in Wilbur Square, Bicentennial Park, North Escalante Park, South Escalante Park and the streets in-between. Free parking is available throughout Boulder City and paid parking is available in the old Boulder City Airport parking lot. Paid transit service from this location is available through the RTC.

2009 sponsorship packages and media RFP's will be sent out in February and partnerships will be announced later this year. 2008 Media Partners included all local Greenspun Media Group publications, Mix 94.1/CBS Radio and KLAS TV – Channel 8.
